EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN PROGRAM

PROGRAM DETAILS

The Emergency Medical Technician program is in person. This program is 10-16 weeks long with variation based on the schedule times with the clinical hours completed throughout the program. The program consists of two courses completed in succession.

- ET90A Introduction to EMS System
- EMT90 Emergency Medical Technician

This short-term program is intended to prepare students to become Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs) to work for an ambulance service or in related fire departments, hospitals, or other rescue services. This program is specifically for noncredit students who are seeking training in the public safety field for immediate employment. Furthermore, this program will also provide foundational skills and training for students to enter into more advanced public safety programs. Students must pass both core courses to earn the Emergency Medical Technician certificate.

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS AND DISCLOSURES

We advise that all scholars complete these required immunizations prior to completing their Human Touch Healthcare course to ensure that they are ready for enrollment. For those who have not been immunized, this process could take up to 6 months.

The following is required prior to enrollment in the program.

- Physical Health Screen – completed by Healthcare Professional
 - Blood Tests & Titers results must be attached
- TB Screening
 - 2-step TB (2 TB consecutive tests)
 - TB Gold (blood draw)
 - Lab results must be attached
- Flu Vaccination (during flu season)
 - Proof of vaccine must be attached
- COVID 19 Vaccinations
 - Please note that this may include boosters
 - Copy of card is required

Please note: All scholars may be asked to show proof of immunizations required by the clinical sites and some programs with onsite coursework prior to enrollment or an externship.

ENROLLMENT DISCLOSURES

After your successful registration for the course through Futuro Health, Mt. SAC School of Continuing Education will require the following:

- SCE Application
- Be at least 18 years of age or older
- High school diploma, GED, or equivalent
- Background check
 - Livescan submission will be required
- Be physically able to perform all duties required
- Have valid car insurance for transportation to/from hospitals
- Social Security Number or Tax ID Number (TIN)
- Drug & Alcohol Test
 - Urinalysis
- Physical exam performed by a Physician – dated within 3 months prior to start of clinical
 - This included proof of immunizations such as:
 - Pass a TB Test (Tuberculosis) or Clear Chest X-Ray
 - Proof of COVID-19 Vaccination
 - Proof of Flu vaccine

Materials that you must collect from the provider:

- Parking Pass
- Mt. SAC Student I.D. Card
- Mt. SAC EMT Polo
- Book – AAOS Emergency Care & Transportation of the Sick and Injured 12th Edition
 - No Workbook is Required
- Penlight with Pupil Gauge
 - No LED Version
- Watch with Seconds Displayed
 - Can be Digital or Analog
- Safety Glasses
 - Prescription Glasses alone are NOT ACCEPTED since they do not meet OSHA and ANSI Regulations
- Nametag Holder
- Blood Pressure Cuff
- Stethoscope
 - Single tubing is recommended
- Nitrile Gloves
 - CANNOT BE LATEX – Any color is okay

EXTERNSHIP DISCLOSURES

Please note that an externship is an integral part of program completion and scholars will need to adhere to the following requirements:

- Physical exam – dated within 3 months prior to start of clinical
- Be physically able to perform all duties required
- Have valid car insurance for transportation to/from hospitals

PROGRAM AND LAB SCHEDULES

The Emergency Medical Technician course consists of 10-16 weeks depending on the schedule chosen of in-person training. The program is broken down into two courses with individual schedules. Please note that scholars will only need to choose one of the schedules listed below (Either the MWF Day or MW Eve).

- ET90A Introduction to EMS System
 - Wednesday, Thursday, & Friday 8:00AM – 4:40PM
 - Monday & Wednesday 4:00PM – 9:05PM
- EMT90 Emergency Medical Technician
 - Wednesday, Thursday, & Friday 8:00AM – 5:40PM
 - Monday & Wednesday 4:00PM – 9:05PM

STUDENT OUT OF POCKET COSTS

Futuro Health covers the cost of tuition for your Emergency Medical Technician program, however, there will be some out-of-pocket costs required from the scholar for enrollment.

- History and Physical Exam – approximately \$250.00
- Mybackground Check – Cost is \$44.00
- NREMT – Cost is \$104.00
- Black BDU-Styled or Cargo Pants – approximately \$60.00
 - Recommended Brands: 5.11 or Dickies
- Black Boots – approximately \$110.00
 - Must be Polishable
 - Firefighter 1 boots are not required
- Black Leather Belt – approximately \$15.00
