



PHARMACY TECHNICIAN PROGRAM CHECKLIST

As you start your Futuro Health Scholar Journey, we want to ensure that you are set up for success. Please carefully review the acknowledgements, checklist items and timeline below to confirm your readiness and willingness to successfully complete all requirements for the Pharmacy Technician Program.

ACKNOWLEDGE THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS

- Access to a working computer & reliable internet source. *If you do not have a working computer, Futuro Health will provide you with a Chromebook.*

- Ability to commit to 4 - 6 months for program completion. This includes 2 months in the prerequisite course – Human Touch Healthcare, followed by 2 months of technical program learning and a mandatory 130 hours in a non-paid externship.

- Access to your Futuro Health scholar portal to complete the following:
 - Save Coach contact information (main point of contact)
 - Sign all Scholar Agreements
 - Complete Application & Registration Payment
 - Access Education Journey
 - View Career Services

- Acknowledgement of Immunization Requirements as stated in scholar agreements and application.

PRIOR TO STARTING HUMAN TOUCH HEALTHCARE PREREQUISITE COURSE

- Connect with your Futuro Health Coach to select & confirm a start date for Human Touch Healthcare.
 - Commit to chosen start date. **You will only be granted 1 start date change if necessary*

- Pay \$150 application fee in your Futuro Health scholar portal

- Prepare for success
 - Communicate to your Coach what you are excited for and what will be the greatest challenge.
 - Acknowledge your responsibility to meet with your Coach upon any changes to your agreed upon timeline.
 - Create a personalized time management plan.



- Gather a network of support from your family and friends. Accountability is key!

HUMAN TOUCH HEALTHCARE PREREQUISITE

- Check your email 1 week prior to start date for course & orientation information
 - Orientation email to include: Canvas access information & course information. **You will likely need to reply acknowledging that you have read & received this email.*
- Engage in all coursework as required for participation
- Attend required live-sessions (once per week)
- Connect with Human Touch Healthcare Facilitator as necessary to discuss your coursework
- Review Education Provider choices
 - Meet with your Coach to discuss Education Provider
 - Confirm start date for Pharmacy Technician program
- Complete Human Touch Healthcare capstone assignment & obtain passing grade. **A passing score is required in order to secure a Futuro Health Scholarship into the Pharmacy Technician Program.***

ENROLLMENT INTO PHARMACY TECHNICIAN PROGRAM

- Engage with Ed Provider outreach. **Ed Provider will contact you directly – you must engage with Ed Provider to begin enrollment process. They will become your new point-of-contact in your scholar journey*
- Provide & complete all required enrollment steps as assigned by Ed Provider
 - Complete and turn in all necessary forms
- Acknowledge that your Education Provider may require you to complete the following:
 - Drug Screen
 - Immunization records and updates
 - Criminal Background Check
 - Other minor out-of-pocket costs associated with program completion

**These are completed at Educational Provider's discretion and are not covered under your Futuro Health tuition scholarship*

- Ask any & all questions you may have to both Ed Provider and Futuro Health Coach
- Have schedule availability & time management plan in place
- Prepare for non-paid externship hours – including caregiving arrangements & current job awareness
