PROGRAM DETAILS

The RCI Phlebotomy Technician Program (CPT1) program is an on-campus, in-person course. This program is 88 hours long with clinical externship of 1 week (40hrs) completed at the end.

A Certified Phlebotomy Technician (CPT1) is a trained professional authorized to collect blood samples through skin puncture and venipuncture. They ensure accurate collection and labeling of blood samples, follow proper equipment usage, and maintain patient information in a database. Certified Phlebotomists also provide comfort to nervous patients during the blood drawing process.

At RCI, we ensure our students meet the highest industry standards through comprehensive CPT1 training and extensive hands-on experience. Our program is designed to equip you with the skills and knowledge needed to excel, preparing you to confidently perform the vital duties of a Licensed Phlebotomist upon graduation.

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS AND DISCLOSURES

We advise that all scholars complete these required immunizations prior to completing their Human Touch Healthcare course to ensure that they are ready for enrollment. For those who have not been immunized, this process could take up to 6 months.

This program requires that students submit their proof of immunization on or before the 2nd week of the Program and prior to the externship scheduling.

- 2 x MMR (Measles, Mumps & Rubella) or titer immunity in the last 3 months
- 2 x Varicella (chickenpox) or titer immunity in the last 3 months
- 3 x Hepatitis B or titer immunity in the last 3 months
- Optional: 2 x Covid 19 (Proof of injections -NOTE: there is a 3-week gap needed between the 1st and 2nd immunization) and booster.
 - Covid Booster- Scholars may need to have additional boosters nearing the time of their externship.
- One Step PPD (TB) or blood titer showing non-infection –
 - This will likely not be required until nearing your externship start date (typically within 6 months). This is either a one or two step PPD Mantoux test, blood titer or chest Xray.

Please note: All scholars may be asked to show proof of immunizations required by the clinical sites and some programs with onsite coursework prior to enrollment or clinical externship.

ENROLLMENT DISCLOSURES

After your successful registration for the course through Futuro Health, Regan Career Institute will require the following:

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*Please note that any of the information listed above is subject to change

- Identification documentation – valid, non-expired California ID
 - Please note you must be older than 18 years old
- High school diploma/GED
- The state of California requires a background check

PROGRAM AND LAB SCHEDULES

The CPT1 course consists of 48 hours of in-person lecture and skills training and 40 hours for clinicals completed at the end of the course. RCI has multiple schedule offerings. Possible in person lecture/skills training schedules include:

- Weekends:
 - Friday, Saturday, Sunday 8:00AM – 5:30PM
- Weekdays:
 - Tuesday, Thursday, Friday 8:00AM – 5:30PM

Please note that not all schedules will be available for each start date and schedules are subject to change.

EXTERNSHIP DISCLOSURES

RCI will coordinate your externship location. The externship is 40 hours in length, and scholars will be required to complete 50 successful venipunctures during the externship. Please note that an externship is an integral part of program completion and scholars will need to adhere to the following clinical Externship requirements:

- Necessary requirements (i.e. vaccinations) must be met prior to approval
- Regular business hours Monday – Friday 8AM – 5PM availability will be required for the duration of the 40-hour externship

STUDENT OUT OF POCKET COSTS

Futuro Health covers the cost of tuition for your CPT1 program, however, there will be some potential out-of-pocket costs required from the scholar for enrollment.

Program specific out of pocket optional costs may include the following:

- Additional Uniforms/scrubs if you require more than what is given
- Cost for physical exam if required by site
- Cost for special, non-standard vaccinations, and/or blood titers as required by site
